Bairnsdale Regional Hospital has also implemented their Safe Sleep Program and every mother receives a swaddle from Cooper and a safe sleep book.

HOW IT BEGAN

The Brighter Days Foundation was formed in 2012 to offer support to two charities; the DEBRA Foundation (Dystrophic Epidermolysis Bullosa Research Association) and SUDC (Sudden Unexplained Death In Childhood). Through a friend, whose child had been diagnosed with the debilitating EB disease, the band the Smokin' O'Briens played a backyard EB awareness gig where they met sufferers Eliza and Tilly.

So touched by the plight of these children, musicians Matt Powell, John Nixon and Steve Dundon decided to do something more to help. At the same time their bike-riding buddy Jim Henwood's close friends Rob



and Kylie Trewin had lost their son Cooper to SUDC whilst another great mate and Bright local Jason Reid was experiencing first hand the trauma of a very sick child.

Collectively the guys wanted to do something that would make a real difference to those suffering. They put their heads together and drew on the significant resources of their wider circle of friends who were also motorcycle and car enthusiasts and so the Brighter Days Foundation began. Now in its sixth year, the committee and some very passionate volunteers have managed to raise much needed funds through donations, raffles, auctions and events.

DEBRA FOUNDATION

There are over 1,000 people living in Australia that are affected by 'the worst disease you've never heard of' Epidermolysis Bullosa also called EB. EB is likened to having 3rd degree burns and the skin blisters and breaks at the slightest touch. EB sufferers go through extremely painful 3-hour bleach bath and dressing changes every second day.

DEBRA Australia is a volunteer-based organisation that receives no government funding and relies on supporters like Brighter Days to help us deliver our life changing programs. Brighter Days has enabled us to continue improving the lives of children and adults living with EB, the debilitating and sometimes fatal condition, by providing necessary support services, medical supplies, aids and equipment, assistance with transition to independent living, funding





research focusing on different aspects of EB and our EB Nurse Program which employs dedicated staff across Australia helping families with the daunting journey of life with EB as well as facilitating crucial medical services.

By supporting this event, you are directly impacting lives of sick children, and together we are turning ideas into life-changing programs. With your support we can continue to make this impact on EB families across Australia ensuring that they are receiving the best possible care. While continuing to deliver these programs our next step is working towards funding a second EB Transitional Nurse in Brisbane and Youth Program offering counselling and mental health support.

COOPER TREWIN MEMORIAL SUDC RESEARCH FUND

The Cooper Trewin Memorial SUDC Research Fund was established after the tragic passing of Cooper Trewin on 6 February 2010 aged 16 months and is supporting SIDS and Kids to fund advocacy and Australian research into the cause for sudden and unexplained death in children. "Sudden Unexplained Death In Childhood (SUDC) is the sudden and unexpected death of a child over the age of 12 months, which remains unexplained after a thorough case investigation is conducted." [Krous et al. 2005]

Money raised from Brighter Days has assisted in the development of the Cooper Trewin Brighter Days

Neuroimaging Study which has developed the ability to see into a living brain with MRI technology near to what can be seen under a microscope. This has saved children's lives and has far reaching possibilities in the diagnosis and treatment of many childhood diseases.

DRAGON

Dragon is back, as good as ever, fronted by the legendary kiwi singer Mark Williams. This band rocks its way through a long list of iconic songs that are part of the national estate.

Todd started the band in 1973 and Marc Hunter joined in 1974.

Dragon has had many hits over the years and have sold over 2 million albums. Bass player, Todd Hunter reformed the band in 2007 after a much needed break and Dragon have played over 700 shows since then.

Todd and Mark are joined by Canadian guitar slinger, Bruce Reid and drum wizard Pete Drummond. The band is known for anthems like April Sun In Cuba, Are You Old Enough, Rain, Speak No Evil, Young Years, This Time, Sunshine, Celebrate and Dreams of Ordinary Men.

Dragon was inducted into the Australian Hall Of Fame in 2008. The current live show evolves from an intimate beginning to a spirited, electric, uplifting finale. Mark sings each song in a way that is familiar to the audience but completely his own and strong playing and vocal harmonies have the crowd singing along as if everyone on the room is in the band.



PSEUDO ECHO

Pseudo Echo pioneered the 1980s electro sound in Australia and quickly established themselves as one of the most successful and influential bands in the country.

With smash hits like "Listening" and "A Beat for You" from their debut gold album "Autumnal Park" followed by the platinum selling "Love An Adventure" album which featured the hits "Don't Go", "Living in a Dream" and the title track "Love an Adventure" the band was set to make its mark on the international stage.

Brian Canham (singer/songwriter/guitarist) then came up with the masterstroke to record a killer version of the song "Funky Town". At just 24 years of age Brian produced a worldwide smash hit which saw them top the Australian charts for 12 weeks, soar to the USA and UK Top 10 as well as dozens of other countries. Pseudo Echo's Funky Town came to be the unofficial anthem of the 1980s.

Pseudo Echo's ever evolving look and sound, continues to attract a whole new generation of fans... releasing new music with albums such as "Teleporter", "Ultraviolet", "Live at the Viper Room" (recorded at LA's iconic Viper Room).

AND for 2018 a BRAND NEW single; the band's sizzling "electro funk rock" version of Ike & Tina Tuner's 70's classic "Nutbush City Limits".

Pseudo Echo continues their musical legacy, embarking on international tour dates for 2018.



THE BADLOVES

The Badloves are an Australian band formed by frontman Michael Spiby, orginating in Melbourne, Australia in 1989. The band is famous for hits including 'Lost', 'Green Limousine', 'Slave', 'Caroline', and a cover of 'The Weight' with Jimmy Barnes. The Badloves have released a number of studio and live albums as well as EP's, won three ARIA awards and two Australin Music Awards and toured internationally.

The line up includes front-man and founder Michael Spiby (lead guitar and lead vocals), Jeff Consi (drums), Adam Rigley (keys) and Stephen 'Irish' OPrey (bass), returning to the fold after two decades.

The band originally comprised of Michael Spiby (lead guitar and lead vocals), Ian Whiteside (bass), John Perosa (drums) and Michael's brother John Spiby (keyboards) and used two working titles *The Badloves and DC3*, both coined by Michael. *DC3* soon gave way to the more 'retro' moniker *The Badloves*.

A native New Yorker Jeff has been playing drums for nearly 40 years, being exposed to recording studios from a young age after following in his father's footsteps as a drummer. Joining *The Badloves* in May 2016, Adam has been in the music industry for the last 15 years performing as a keyboardist and vocalist and has recorded and toured extensively whilst also working as a songwriter and numerous artists. 'Irish' the band's bass player and Michael go way back, having toured Europe together in the late 80's and early 90's.

The Badloves have recently released a live album titled Raw Honey in August 2016 (engineered and mixed by multi-ARIA award winning sound engineer Doug Brady) recorded at Melbourne's Caravan Club on February 14th 2016.

After numerous line-up changes over the years, fans agree the band has never sounded better and *The Badloves* continue to enjoy a loyal fanbase, touring venues and festivals all over the country. Inspired by the past, *The Badloves* are a band that's very much focused on the future.



MELBOURNE SKA ORCHESTRA

Formed in 2003 the Melbourne Ska Orchestra is an orchestra with a difference. Comprising up to 36 members this juggernaut contains some of Australia's finest musicians and performers. The band can perform with as little as 18 members and as many as 36. Led and directed by the energetic and charismatic Nicky Bomba (John Butler Trio, Bomba, Bustamento), they are a force to be reckoned with.

The band's debut self-titled release resulted in sell-out national shows, multiple major festival appearances, three international tours and a host of awards and nominations. The new album Sierra-Kilo-Alpha, was released on April 22, 2016. Showcasing a new trajectory sonically, it respects the roots of the genre retransmitting 2 Tone signals while introducing new hybrids that are fresh and exciting.

Melbourne Ska Orchestra's live performance is explosive and infectious. Their unique take on the genre of Ska has wowed audiences all over the world. From Montreal to New York, Istanbul to London and with the approval of Reggae and Ska pioneers like Stranger Cole, Owen Gray, Carlos Malcolm, Ranking Roger and Neville Staples, to name a few, the Melbourne Ska Orchestra is resonating with audiences worldwide – young and old.

The last few years have seen 'one of Australia's hottest bands' release two new singles, 'Baby It's You' and 'Black and Blue', appearing on countless TV & radio shows and performing around the country (most recently as part of the Gold FM concert series).

Ally Fowler, Tottie Goldsmith and Evie von Bibra are The Chantoozies. Collectively and individually they have contributed to Australia's rich music, film, television and theatre culture. They have a unique and entertaining energy that they bring to every show, singing a combination of their original songs and some covers from various eras.

The girls reunited in 2006 for the national 'Countdown Spectacular' tour and have never looked back!



SCREAMIN' EAGLES

Capturing the spirit of the legendary Eagles live on stage, the Screamin' Eagles line-up includes vocalist, three guitars, bass, drums and keys. You can close your eyes and think you are at an Eagles gig with the incredible harmonies and legendary rock sound.

The line-up includes front man Steve Dundon on vocals/guitar, Matt Powell vocals/guitar, John JD Dallimore vocals/guitar, Norm Falvo keys/vocals, Kevin Murphy drums/vocals and Lincoln Jones on bass.

Screamin' Eagles have played all around Australia entertaining crowds with their stunning vocals, incredible musicianship and great entertainment.



RAW BRIT

"If you remember the 60 and 70's .. you weren't there" was never a true evaluation for the four members of Melbourne band 'Raw Brit'.

"If you were there, how could you have missed the greatest time in music history?" infers lead singer Mick Pealing.

In the swinging 60's, Britain (and the world) was undergoing a profound cultural change. Such an awakening had never been seen in modern society and the historical significance of this period is well documented in music.

Guitarist Bob Spencer who attributes his virtuoso rock-blues style to Paul Kossoff of 'Free', muses: "if I'd have known how important British music was going to be to me, I would have held more allegiance to the Queen and spoke with a Cockney accent'.

Anger mixed with an unbridled mistrust of authority, fuelled a need for a voice and it was through music that best expressed these feelings.

"It was also the seminal sound for all those wanna-be popstars of today .. and sadly, they probably don't even know it" admits bass player John Favaro.

The 60's and 70's enforced a new essence with the intent of making a direct connection to a displaced youth. Created out of adversity with a necessity for a social change .. the corner had turned forever!

Raw Brit has played the music they love with a healthy irreverence to excited sell-out audiences around Melbourne for 5 years.



JACUZZI MASTERPIECE

Jacuzzi Masterpiece is a dynamic funk band that gets the crowd moving from the first note. The 5-piece band from Melbourne formed early 2016, after a late-night jam between Michael and Aaron, bonding over their shared love of infectious riffs and funky grooves. Jacuzzi Masterpiece released a self-titled EP, and a few video clips in 2017 and aim to release their second EP in mid- 2018.

Turk Tresize is the embodiment of dusty backroads, Australian rock 'n' roll. Turk's music drifts through the best decades of Rock 'n' Roll and takes his listeners on a story-telling trip through time.

Turk has managed to perform music across the globe, operate a successful annual music festival and launch a record label that released his highly-touted debut album, Soul Casino. Turk continues to tell his intriguing story in the form of song with his sophomore album, If It Is to Be.

SHAUN KLINGER BAND

Born in Melbourne, Shaun Klinger's love of the quitar started at an early age when his father introduced him to all of the classics, notably, Buddy Holly, Eddie Cochran and Chuck Berry. His first live music experience was a Legends of Rock gig at Melbourne Tennis Centre. But Shaun's real obsession with the guitar started when late one night he was watching the TV and a special band came on....AC/DC live at the Apollo. Around the same time his dad handed him a bunch of records from an old friend's collection. Jimi Hendrix's 'Are you experienced' was in there and from the first notes he was hooked. With that inspiration ingrained Shaun asked his parents for a quitar, which became his constant companion.

At 13 years old Shaun was asked to join his first band. He was recruited and given the job of lead guitarist, playing school formals and house parties. After finishing school Shaun decided to take up full time work as a musician playing 5 nights a week in night clubs and pubs while playing his original music on the off nights. By then his musical tastes covered everyone from Pink Floyd and the Doors, Jazz to Country. The love of guitar sounds had stuck with Shaun since hearing Hendrix and the music from that period onwards was adventurous and creative. Shaun started making his own effects and experimenting with his own quitar setups over the next few years.

When a lot of the venues started going out of business and closing their band nights down Shaun needed to stay within the industry. He was already working at a local guitar amp factory 'Ulbrick' in which he learnt much about the ins and outs of the musical equipment industry. When that shut down, Shaun decided to set up his own Effects making business 'Klinger Custom Pedals.' "Things took off really fast," Shaun says "I was making pedals for Ian Moss (Cold Chisel), Brett Kingman (James Reyne), Bob Spencer (The Angels) and many other well-known and cool musicians, it got to a point there was a real demand for orders each week'.

Over the past 20 years Shaun has travelled all over Australia with various bands playing at many key festivals, venues, Radio shows and the odd spot on T.V. Whilst on tour in the states it gave him the ability to refocus on his own music and the bands that were of most importance to him.


The life and story of Eliza and her family as they dealt with EB has always and will always be a crucial part of the Brighter Days story.
