HOW ITBEGAN

The Brighter Days Foundation was formed in 2012 to offer support to two charities; the DEBRA Foundation (Dystrophic Epidermolysis Bullosa Research Association) and SUDC (Sudden Unexplained Death In Childhood). Through a friend, whose child had been diagnosed with the debilitating EB disease, the band the Smokin' O'Briens played a backyard EB awareness gig where they met sufferers Eliza and Tilly. So touched by the plight of these children, musicians Matt Powell, John Nixon and Steve Dundon decided to do something more to help. At the same time their bike-riding buddy Jim Henwood's close friends Rob and Kylie Trewin had lost their son Cooper to SUDC whilst another great mate and Bright local Jason Reid was experiencing first hand the trauma of a very sick child.

Collectively the guys wanted to do something that would make a real difference to those suffering. They put their heads together and drew on the significant resources of their wider circle of friends who were also motorcycle and car enthusiasts and so the Brighter Days Foundation began. Now in its fourth year, the committee and some very passionate volunteers have managed to raise more than \$550,000 through donations, raffles, auctions and events.

DEBRA FOUNDATION



Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) is a rare disease whereby the skin blisters and peels at the slightest touch. Living with EB has been likened to living with third degree burns. It is very painful, and sufferers must be bandaged every day with dressings to protect and medicate their wounds. EB is characterised by skin fragility with blister formation occurring spontaneously or following minor trauma. EB can be broadly divided into three major catagories: Simplex, Junctional and Dystropic. These catagories can be further subtyped based on inheritance and clinical features. It is estimated that there are around 1,000 people in Australia who have some form of EB and over 500,000 worldwide. It occurs in all racial and ethnic groups and affects males and females equally. EB is not always evident at birth. Milder cases of EB may become apparent when a child crawls, walks, runs or when young adults become more physically active.

Money raised from Brighter Days has assisted individuals and families all over Australia living with EB. It has provided them with many items including wheel chairs, ramps, specially made clothing, shoes, air conditioners, medical equipment and supplies. Brighter Days has also contributed to the EB Nurse Program which employs dedicated part-time EB nurses in Victoria, Queensland and New South Wales. COOPER TREWIN MEMORIAL SUDC RESEARCH FUND

The Cooper Trewin Memorial SUDC Research Fund was established after the tragic passing of Cooper Trewin on 6 February 2010 aged 16 months and is supporting SIDS and Kids to fund advocacy and Australian research into the cause for sudden and unexplained death in children. "Sudden Unexplained Death In Childhood (SUDC) is the sudden and unexpected death of a child over the age of 12 months, which remains unexplained after a thorough case investigation is conducted." (Krous et al. 2005)

Money raised from Brighter Days has assisted in the development of the Cooper Trewin Brighter Days Neuroimaging Study which is being conducted over the next two years at the Boston Children's Hospital by Dr Hannah Kinney. The study aims to develop a biomarker of subtle hippocampal maldevelopment in asymptomatic toddlers at risk for sudden unexpected death with novel state-of-the-art neuroimaging techniques. www.sudc.org.au

ROSS WILSON

Ross Wilson is probably the only person in Australian rock music who can't make a comeback simply because he's never been away. In a career that spans over 40 years, Ross remains one of this country's most respected artists. From Daddy Cool to Mondo Rock, as a solo artist, or as songwriter of classics such as *Eagle Rock*, *Cool World* and *A Touch of Paradise*, or producer of the legendary Skyhooks, Jo Jo Zep, The Johnnys and The Screaming Jets, Ross's involvement with success has continued unabated. He fronted Daddy Cool and exploded out of the 70s playing rootsy 50s sounds. He went on to form Mondo Rock who surfed the contemporary scene with chart topping singles and albums. As a solo performer and major songwriter he has continued to achieve success and make his mark with his songs being recorded by a diverse mix of artists including Jimmy Barnes, John Farnham, DEF-FX, Custard, Jennifer Rush (EU), Troy Cassar-Daley, Leslie Avril, Hey Gringo, You Am I, Uncle Bill, Keke (Spain), Renee Geyer, Christine Anu, Duane Jarvis (US), Elkie Brooks (UK), Ann Kirkpatrick & Lee Kernaghan, Sovereign, Pleasantville, Beccy Cole, Sonic Jihad, and The Wiggles.



DARYL BRAITHWAITE

Daryl Braithwaite first found fame in the 1970s as lead singer of Sherbet who produced 20 national top 40 singles. They were the first Australian band to top the \$1 million mark in album sales, with a total of 15 albums and 30 singles to their credit. During this period, Daryl won the Australian King of Pop award three times. In 1988 he released the phenomenally successful album *Edge* which spent over a year in the national Aria chart, peaking at #1 for several weeks. In 1989 it became the highest selling CD in Sony Music Australia's history, spawning five hit singles including *One Summer.* In 1990 Daryl released his follow-up album *Rise* with another five hit singles. The most popular was undoubtedly *The Horses*, holding the #1 position on the national charts over three consecutive weeks. The single was voted 'Australian Song of the Year' at the 1991 Australian Music Awards. Braithwaite's extraordinary career continues to go from strength to strength and he remains an integral part of the evolution of Australian popular music.



Bjorn Again is regarded as the most successful tribute band of all time. Their re-creation of ABBA's timeless hits, combined with all the glitzy 70s stage costumes, Swenglish banter and hilarious stage antics, creates the ultimate live show which has been described as 'pure joy', 'the ultimate escape' and 'the most fun you can have wearing platform shoes and flares'. Bjorn Again has performed over 6000 concerts in over 100 countries worldwide and sold out concerts in India, China, South America, Australia, New Zealand, Scandinavia, all over Europe, Asia, USA and Canada. Bjorn Again have played at all the major concert venues in the world including The Sydney Opera House, The Royal Albert Hall and Wembley Stadium; at major rock festivals such as Reading, T in the Park and Glastonbury; and performed private shows for Bill Gates, Rowan Atkinson and Russell Crowe.



SCREAMIN' EAGLES

Capturing the spirit of the legendary Eagles live on stage, the **Screamin' Eagles** line-up includes six vocalists, three guitars, bass, drums and keyboards. You can close your eyes and think you are at an Eagles gig with the incredible harmonies and legendary rock sound. The line-up includes front man and singer/guitarist **Steve Dundon, Matt Powell** on lead vocals and guitar, **John JD Dallimore** on lead vocals and guitar, keyboard player and vocalist **Norm Falvo, Kevin Murphy** on vocals and drums and **Lincoln Jones** on bass. Screamin' Eagles have played all around Australia entertaining crowds with their stunning vocals and incredible musicianship. Individually these band members have a rich musical pedigree and the combination on stage makes for a fantastic entertainment experience.

SMOKIN' O'BRIENS



Playing all your favourites the **Smokin' O'Briens** are sure to get you singing and dancing and probably up on the stage as well. These guys have been performing in Bright for over 20 years now and yes they are the band featured on the mural on the back wall of the Alpine Hotel. The band includes some of the key players behind the Brighter Days Festival including **Steve Dundon**, **Matt Powell** and **John Nixon** from Chocolate Starfish. They will be joined on stage by guest drummer **Geoff Cox** and some of the guys from the Screamin' Eagles to bring you a show that is big on entertainment. Put your party shoes on for this one!

PAUL HICKS & THE YARD DOGS

After stints as frontman and songwriter for Melbourne roots music bands The Haybalers



and Broken Spoke, **Paul Hicks** emerged in 2005 with a solo album, *Kettle of Fish*, which led critics to draw comparisons with Bruce Springsteen, Bob Dylan and Paul Kelly. His follow-up album *Food for the Journey* was released a few years later to critical acclaim. Hicks has appeared at venues and festivals throughout Australia and Europe. His touring band, **The Yard Dogs**, comprises **Dave O'Brien** on bass, **Nick Brown** on electric guitar and vocals and **Ron Mahony** on drums and vocals. Recording of a third album is underway.

DONNA FISK



Donna Fisk is an award-winning Australian country singer, songwriter, recording artist and producer. Donna's rich and rewarding career to date has seen her win five Southern Hemisphere Country Music Awards and the award for Best Female Entertainer at the Australian Country Music Awards. Her latest single and video released in the UK Still In Love with You reached No 2 on CM&T video and radio charts in 2015. Donna is currently in pre-production for her Nashville recording deal for a new album project in 2016.

MRBLUEZ

Mr Bluez are a five piece blues band from Melbourne. Bringing you a classic blues sound is **Mark Turner** on lead vocals, **Chris Natoli** on guitar, **Lou Toth** on sax, **Jeff Buckland** on bass and **Lorie Strickland** on drums. They are currently working on their third album following on from their earlier albums *Live at St Andrews Hotel* and *Time For A Change*.


