The Brighter Days Foundation was formed in 2012 to offer support to two charities; the DEBRA Foundation (Dystrophic Epidermolysis Bullosa Research Association) and SUDC (Sudden Unexplained Death In Childhood). Through a friend, whose child had been diagnosed with the debilitating EB disease, the band the Smokin' O'Briens played a backyard EB awareness gig where they met sufferers Eliza and Tilly.

So touched by the plight of these children, musicians Matt Powell, John Nixon and Steve Dundon decided to do something more to help. At the same time their bike-riding buddy Jim Henwood's close friends Rob and Kylie Trewin had lost their son Cooper to SUDC whilst another

great mate and Bright local Jason Reid was experiencing first hand the trauma of a very sick child.

Collectively the guys wanted to do something that would make a real difference to those suffering.

They put their heads together and drew on the significant resources of their wider circle of friends who were also motorcycle and car enthusiasts and so the Brighter Days Foundation began.

With the festival now in its 10th year, we are proud to have donated over \$2.5 Million to our charities, a figure we could not have imagined when we started in 2013.

DEBRA AUSTRALIA

DEBRA Australia is a not-for-profit volunteerbased organisation that does not receive any direct Government funding and works tirelessly to support those living with a rare skin blistering disease called Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB)

EB is a rare disease whereby the skin blisters and peels at the slightest touch. Living with EB has been likened to living with third degree burns. It is very painful, and sufferers must be bandaged every day with dressings to protect and medicate their wounds. Recent estimates suggest more than 1000 people currently live with EB in Australia, and more than 500,000 people worldwide.

DEBRA Australia assists in improving the lives of children and adults living with EB by providing necessary support services, medical supplies, aids and equipment, assistance with transition to independent living and research focusing on different aspects of EB.





In addition to this DEBRA delivers a number of programs to support and educate families living with EB as well as hosts seminars to train and educate specialist health professionals and nurses. DEBRA Australia also works with DEBRA International to provide support for EB families worldwide and aims to facilitate opportunities for EB research to find approaches to cure and develop therapies for EB.

Our vision is a world where no one suffers from the painful genetic skin condition Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB).

For more than 10 years, Brighter Days has supported the work of DEBRA Australia and has become one of DEBRA Australia's most valued partners. Since its inception in 2013, The Brighter Days Foundation has raised more than \$900,000 to support our programs and all our EB families and we are truly thankful for The Brighter Days Foundation. EB RESEARCH **FOUNDATION**

When Tilly Wilkes was born with Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) in Melbourne in 2011, it turned her family's world upside down. The Wilkes family had never heard of EB and to learn of the painful and cruel life their daughter was about to face was devastating. Business leader, Scott Didier AM, heard of Tilly's story and with friends established the EB Research Foundation, now the EB Research Partnership (Australia) to raise significant funds to invest into science and research to find a cure for Epidermolysis Bullosa.

EB is a family of rare genetic disorders that affect the body's largest organ: the skin. Individuals with EB lack critical proteins that bind the skin's two layers together. Without these proteins, the skin tears apart, blisters, and shears off leading to severe pain, disfigurement, and wounds that may never heal.

EB is a devastating disease. It affects kids from birth. But what makes this cause different is we believe we can actually do something about it in our lifetime.



In 2021 the support of Brighter Days helped to us to fund 13 innovative research projects in 6 countries, accelerating cutting-edge technology with

1-4 years and will lead to significantly improving the quality of lives of those living with EB or can be curative.

Our model and the research we fund can advance cures beyond EB for the 7,000 rare diseases that affect 400 million people around the world.

With the support of Brighter Days finding a cure for EB is not an if, it's a when.



COOPER TREWIN MEMORIAL SUDC RESEARCH FUND

Cooper Trewin



The Cooper Trewin Foundation was established after the tragic passing of Cooper Trewin on 6 February 2010, aged 16 months.

Cooper passed for no known reason and the foundation was established to support research into the cause of sudden and unexplained death in children.

As a parent who is told by a pathologist after an autopsy that we had a healthy little boy without sickness, injury or disease leaves a lot of unanswered questions.

Primarily effecting children between the ages of 1 and 4, each year roughly 224 families worldwide are subject to the pain of never knowing why their perfectly healthy little boy or girl was taken from

We decided to establish research to try and help find


Cooper's connection to Brighter Days comes via committee members Jim & Lisa Henwood who heard Cooper's Dad talk at an event, deciding at that very

moment to make a difference and help save other families from this same tragedy.

From its humble beginnings, we have been part of this incredible event. We have proudly watched Brighter Days grow into the iconic Australian festival it is today, achieved by the hard work of countless volunteers.

Money raised from Brighter Days has been directly credited with saving children lives, assisting the development of the Cooper Trewin Brighter Days Neuroimaging Study, Brighter Days Genetic Screening and a Safe Sleep Program run out of the Bairnsdale Hospital. This year we look forward to providing an update on the incredible research this event supports, and a new gene modelling study involving Zebrafish.

We would like to thank you for raising funds for such worthwhile charities and keeping Cooper's legacy alive.



Well 10 years ago when we started Brighter Days, none of us could have imagined the growth of this festival. We expected some highs and lows however none of us expected to lose our good friend Neale Brumby of Heavy-Duty magazine. I met Brum and his legend of a wife Viv on global Harley-Davidson media rides and our H-DTV team became very close friends as we rode Harley's across the world.

Brum was a very generous bloke and a great supporter/sponsor of the Brighter Days Festival and all our charities. He grew Heavy-Duty into the best motorcycling magazine in Australia and along with good mate Dave College started ELIZAS RIDE to BRIGHTER DAYS, in memory of our little EB sufferer Eliza Baird who passed away.

Brum contributed to Brighter Days in many ways. From buying raffles tickets, judging bike Show 'n Shines, taking photographs and writing articles, he was always promoting our Festival and his articles, photographs and presence created great memories for many BDF supporters over the years.

We will always remember Neale Brumby...I know I won't forget him and our other great mate Paul Hallam...both taken too quickly.

THIRSTY MERC

THIRSTY MERC are unquestionably one of Australia's finest live acts.

Having released 4 critically acclaimed albums, over 250,000 album sales under their belt, a finalist in the APRA Song of the Year for 20 Good Reasons (which also reached #1 on iTunes in Australia), 5 ARIA Award nominations, Thirsty Merc have found their way into the fabric of Australia's musical landscape.

Thirsty Merc formed in Sydney in 2002 releasing their debut EP, First Work, in September 2003, before being signed to Warner Music. The band's big break came in 2004 with the release of their debut, self titled, album which included the hits, Someday Someday and In The Summertime (the theme for Bondi Rescue since 2006).



Two more studio albums followed - Slideshows in 2007 (#4 ARIA Album) and Mousetrap Heart in 2010 (#14 on the ARIA Album chart) which included radio staples, 20 Good Reasons, Mousetrap Heart and Tommy and Krista.

In 2015, Thirsty Merc released Shifting Gears, their first wholly independent and first new material in five years, and spent the next 18 months crossing the country on 3 extensive tours, running up thousands of Frequent Flyer points and sold out shows. The first single The Good Life was nominated for Rock Work Of The Year at the 2017 APRA awards.

JON STEVENS

After 40 years in the entertainment industry Jon Stevens has truly cemented his place as Aussie rock royalty...

Best known as lead singer of 80's juggernaut Noiseworks, then later fronting INXS in the early 2000's, Jon has also had huge success as a solo artist with his powerhouse vocals and electrifying live shows.

Jon's career has gone from strength-tostrength since his debut consecutive #1 singles 'Montego Bay' & 'Jezebel' in his homeland of New Zealand. Then onto Platinum record



success in Australia with the Noiseworks hits 'Take Me Back', 'Touch' & 'Hot Chilli Woman'. He also received critical acclaim for his performance as Judas in Jesus Christ Superstar alongside John Farnham & Kate Ceberano.

He is about to embark on his 2022 Noiseworks & INXS Collection Tour, where he can pay tribute and bring all the hits of these two legendary bands back to the fans!

VANESSA AMOROSI

This far into her stellar career, Vanessa Amorosi remains one of the most exciting singers on the planet. Her song-writing and dynamic vocal range have seen the artist sell over two million records worldwide. She has released 6 commercially and critically acclaimed studio albums, received sixteen ARIA and APRA nominations, and stopped the world in it's tracks with her performance of 'Heroes Live Forever' and 'Absolutely Everybody' at the Sydney Olympics.

Vanessa reached incredible success in 1999 with her debut single 'Have A Look' followed by mega-hits in Australia and Europe with 'Absolutely Everybody' and 'Shine'. Her debut album 'The Power' reached #1 in Australia, #7 in the United Kingdom, #1 in Hungary and the top 10 in several European countries. This was followed by a European tour performing to thousands of people for over two solid years at the age of 20.

In 2008 Vanessa returned with her third album 'Somewhere In The Real World'. Radio smash-hit 'Perfect' became the most played song by an Australian artist in 2008.

2009 saw the release of Vanessa's most successful album so far, the platinum selling 'Hazardous'. The first single to be released, 'This Is Who I Am' debuted at #1 on the ARIA singles chart and achieved Double Platinum sales. Vanessa had the honour of recording duets with superstar Mary J. Blige and American rock band Hoobastank in 2009. Vanessa has toured worldwide to millions of people, joining the stage and supporting incredible artists including Dave Stewart, KISS, INXS, Rob Thomas, Savage Garden, Macy Gray, Bryan Adams and touring Europe with Joe Cocker.



In 2019 Vanessa released her 5th studio album 'Back To Love' followed by an Australian solo tour and successful festival tours 'Red Hot Summer Tour' and 'One Electric Day'. In March 2020, Vanessa released her first single 'Coming Down Off You' from her album titled 'The Blacklisted Collection'. Having earned her place as one of Australia's most iconic female artists, 'The Blacklisted Collection', was her first record as an independent artist and showcased a rawness and intimacy not heard before. 'The Blacklisted Collection' debuted at #1 on the AIR 100% Independent Music Charts and #2 on the ARIA Digital Albums Chart.

Vanessa will return with her most compelling work to date. Following overseas opportunities, Vanessa permanently re-located to Los Angeles in 2010 to work in Gospel music; song-writing and arranging for world renowned producers and studios across the United States. It's this experience that has led Vanessa to the next chapter in her career as a Soul/Gospel artist. The release of 'Volume 1' and 'Volume 2' in 2021 is the beginning of what's to come.

REECE MASTIN

Reece Mastin is loved all over the countryside and with a career kicking off in the 2000's after winning X Factor Australia in 2011 as a 16 year old and achieving so much at such a young age including 2x Platinum #1 albums, Three Consecutive chart topping Singles, Aria Chart #1,2 and #1 Singles respectively.

Reece now 24 years of age released his first fully independent EP "Suitcase of Stories" in April 2018 debuting at #1 on Itunes Rock Charts and followed that with a National Tour and a Sold Out show in his childhood hometown in the UK.



Reece has a whole heap of new material and he's bloody keen to perform alongside the classics of 2011/12. Forget all you think you know about this young singer and come along to a show and introduce yourself to Reece's new sound at what will be an awesome night. This is a show not to be missed.

JACK JONES

Two times Platinum, 8 times Gold and APRA award winning, Jack Jones singer and songwriter (guitarist) with 90's rock giants Southern Songs has entertained audiences across Australia and the globe.

Born in New York City, Jack Jones arrived in Australia as a ten year old. Even as a youngster, Jack began showing an incredible talent with his guitar playing. At fourteen Jack was already playing professionally in both cover and original bands. At the same time, he was earning a reputation as a very accomplished and well respected studio musician.



After heading back to the United States for several years to further study his craft, Jack eventually returned to Australia and joined the successful 90s band Southern Sons as lead singer/guitarist. With hits such as Heart In Danger, Always & Ever, Hold Me In Your Arms, Waiting For That Train, I Can't Wait Any Longer, Lead Me To Water, Silent Witnesses, & You Were There, his vocal ability was highly praised by both fans and musical peers alike. He not only enjoyed success in Australia, but in Asia, Canada, Germany, & pockets throughout Europe, confirming he was a major talent on the international music scene.

BJORN AGAIN

Dust off those flares, platform shoes and satins and get ready to sing, dance and have the time of your life with Bjorn Again back at Brighter Days.

Bjorn Again are so excited to back playing all of ABBA's biggest hits in an action-packed, highly-entertaining concert that is ABBA-SOLUTE fun for the whole family.

Bjorn Again have performed over 7000 in over 120 countries world-wide, are endorsed by the members of ABBA and are regarded as the most successful tribute show of all time.




Their critically acclaimed shows have been attended by JK Rowling, Tom Jones, Dave Grohl and Paul Kelly, Metallica, Robert Plant, Bill Gates and Nirvana just to name a few.

DARLINGHURST

Darlinghurst is a band of individuals who bring their experience in music together to create a contemporary Country Music sound that has a unique finger print. Second single 'So Long So Long' is from the forthcoming debut album which will be released in 2020. Debut single 'Sorry Won't Get You Back' reached Number 1 on the Australian Country Music airplay chart (Sept/2019). Darlinghurst: JASON RESCH (guitar, vocals) is arguably the most successful Australian songwriter you've never heard of. With his mod-ish mop and immaculate vintage suits, Jason initially looks more suited to The Rolling Stones in 1965 than an alt-country-rock outfit in 2019, but Jase has dedicated a big chunk of his young life to his love of country, having lived and worked in Nashville for years

before recently resettling back to his hometown of Melbourne. CASSIE LEOPOLD & PAGAN NEWMAN (vocals) were a duo long before their powerful harmonies helped forge the foundation of this new quartet. Wait until you hear these voices together!

The Brighter Days Festival is a family-friendly event without age restrictions.

WHERE IS THE RESERVED SEATING?

Reserved seating is at the front behind the 'chair-free' area roped off for dancing.

HOW DO I PICK UP MY TICKET I BOUGHT ONLINE?

You will simply have your ticket barcode (printed or on your device) scanned and show your ID at the gate to collect your tamperproof wristband. You may then come and go from the festival precinct as you like. Please note: All patrons must be wearing a wristband to enter the precinct.
