WELCOME TO BRIGHTER DAYS 2024



Hello and welcome to the 2024 Brighter Days Festival. As I put pen to paper, I feel like it was only yesterday we were here at Pioneer Park for our very successful 2023 festival. If you are new to the Brighter Days family this year – a warm welcome and thank you for being part of this very special event.

Organised by our dedicated committee in this beautiful region and supported by hundreds of volunteers, we come together on the Labour Day weekend each year to raise much-needed funds for very special children's charities and we have an extremely good time whilst we do it! Our 3 day program is jam-packed with live music, fun events and good times with family and friends. Check out the program on pages 8, 9, 10 for all the details.

A lot has happened since we last spoke. We have strong messaging and awareness for Sudden Unexplained Death in Children (SUDC), and we are encouraged by the advancements in Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) research.

In May 2023, a significant milestone was achieved with the approval of the first therapy to treat EB by the United States Food and Drug Administration. Concurrently, various treatments for EB, including the clinical drug trials for Filsuvezm, are undergoing evaluation across 50 clinical centres spanning more than 20 countries.

This breakthrough signifies important progress. While the Brighter Days Foundation did not contribute funding to this specific drug's development, we view it as a positive step forward for the entire EB community which you are all a part of and which we very much support. Your contributions, generosity and donations are helping to improve the outcomes for those living with EB, while keeping trials and research pushing and striving to find a cure. #FightEB

DEBRA Family Support tells us that since the 2023 Brighter Days, there have been 3 more births of babies with severe EB, a decrease from the previous year which is a positive trend. Additionally, there is an expanded program aimed at providing increased support to EB families. Notably, DEBRA has launched a new Podiatry program in Queensland to complement existing programs in NSW and Victoria. Furthermore, their psychology and counselling services have expanded to serve more EB families. The respite program has also grown, accommodating an additional 5 families, totalling 15, allowing EB families to take much-needed breaks from medical appointments and hospitalisations. In addition to the annual Mum's respite, they have also introduced respite opportunities for 12 Dads, offering them essential time away with other Dads of children with EB.

The Brighter Days Foundation extends its support to SUDC, and through the Cooper Trewin Foundation, we contribute funding to ongoing research efforts. Currently, a two-year genetic testing study is underway with Boston Children's Hospital, yielding promising results. The ongoing research holds the potential for identifying genetic markers that can be tested at birth; an immensely promising prospect. Additionally, the Bairnsdale Hospital Sleep Safe Swaddle program continues to thrive, providing new mothers with safe sleep options and educational resources.

We are looking forward to welcoming representatives from our charities along with several of our EB families at Brighter Days 2024 so if you see them around be sure to say hi and have a chat.

The Brighter Days Foundation wishes you all the very best for a fantastic few days filled with fun and fundraising while enjoying the good company of family and friends. We are proud to showcase a remarkable event in the picturesque Bright and express our gratitude to the Alpine Shire for their support.



As parents, receiving the news from a pathologist after an autopsy that our seemingly healthy little boy had no apparent illness, injury, or disease left us with myriad unanswered questions. In response, we decided to initiate research efforts, aiming to contribute to the discovery of a cause for such heartbreaking events.

JASON SINGH

Since their formation in 1997, JASON SINGH and his band TAXIRIDE have engaged audiences with their unique sound and memorable hits. From the chart-topping double platinum debut album "IMAGINATE", and subsequent releases "GARAGE MAHAL", "AXIOMATIC" and "ELECTROPHOBIA", to ARIA awards and the most played song on Australian radio in 2002 "Creepin' Up Slowly", JASON SINGH and his band TAXIRIDE have consistently delivered unforgettable music that has stood the test of time.

Having toured the world and his home country, playing countless sold-out headline shows, Jason Singh and his band TAXIRIDE established themselves as one of Australia's premier live bands. As the charismatic and talented lead singer, JASON SINGH's uniquely recognisable powerhouse vocals are synonymous with TAXIRIDE. Through his commitment to and ongoing performances, JASON SINGH has established himself



as the driving force at the forefront of maintaining TAXIRIDE's continued success and legacy. In addition to his work with his band TAXIRIDE, JASON SINGH has achieved outstanding solo success, earning critical acclaim with his debut solo album HUMANNEQUIN and his #2 iTunes charting tribute album VALE.

From the early breakthrough success to the solo ventures and everything in between, this epic show will celebrate the musical milestones that have solidified both TAXIRIDE and JASON SINGH's place in Australian music history.

RUSSELL MORRIS

Russell Morris is one of Australia's most enduring singers. A major pop star in the late '60s, he went on to become one of the country's first singer/songwriters. Both ends of his career feature predominantly in the soundtrack to the movie **The Dish**. Russell Morris' career started in September 1966 with the formation of the Melbourne group **Somebody's Image**, which rose to prominence with a local hit version of the Joe South song "**Hush**." Morris was convinced to leave Somebody's Image for a solo career. His manager/producer, local music identity lan Meldrum, spent unprecedented hours and money to create a seven-minute production extravaganza around a song called "**The Real Thing.**"

Once the result was released to shocked radio programmers who had never been asked to play such a long Australian single before, it was up to Morris' personality, singing, and performing talents to make the record work. It reached Australia's number one spot in June 1969. Without any promotional support from Morris, "The Real Thing" reached number one in Chicago, Houston, and New York.



The second single -- "Part Three Into Paper Walls" ("The Real Thing" revisited) and "The Girl That I Love" (a pop ballad more indicative of what was to come) -- became a double-sided number one hit, the first time an Australian artist had scored consecutive number ones with their first two singles. Morris, in the meantime, had travelled to the U.K. to help promote the release of "The Real Thing." Russell Morris had now decided to concentrate on his own song writing and with the cream of Australian musicians, spent almost a year painstakingly recording and re-recording what became the Bloodstone album. It was one of the first Australian albums of its kind, the first from an Australian singer/songwriter, and a whole world away from the extravagant "The Real Thing." The hit single from Bloodstone was the resonant, romantic "Sweet Love."

ROGUE TRADERS

Rogue Traders are an electric, pop rock band formed in 2000 by James Ash and Steve Davis, both DJ's and Producers hailing from the UK. In 2004 actress Natalie Bassingthwaighte joined the band, alongside Ash, Tim Henwood and Cameron McGlinchey.

The group shot to fame both locally and internationally, releasing 7 top 20 hits on the ARIA Singles Chart, 'One of My Kind', 'Voodoo Child', 'Way to Go!', 'Watching You', 'We're Coming Home', 'Don't You Wanna Feel' and 'I Never Liked You'.

Rogue Traders have sold over 1 million records worldwide and toured both nationally and internationally. The band have won APRA's for 'Way to Go' and 'In Love Again', an ARIA for 'One of a Kind' and an MTV Award for 'Voodoo Child'.

Over the past few years, the group have taken a break from recording and touring, choosing to spend time on their solo careers and family. Natalie Bassingthwaighte released a solo album, returned to television as host of



'So You Think You Can Dance' and a judge on '
The X Factor'. James, Tim and Cameron continued to
focus heavily on music – writing, producing, recording
and touring. All 4 members have never steered too far
away from music.


Nearly four decades after the band began, the start of 'Onion Skin' remains an irresistible rallying cry: Keep it in! Cut it out! Kick it out!

ARE THERE ANY AGE RESTRICTIONS?

The Brighter Days Festival is a family-friendly event without age restrictions.

WHERE IS THE RESERVED SEATING?

Reserved seating is at the front behind the 'chair-free' area roped off for dancing.

HOW DO I PICK UP MY TICKET I BOUGHT ONLINE?

You will simply have your ticket barcode (printed or on your device) scanned and show your ID at the gate to collect your tamperproof wristband. You may then come and go from the festival precinct as you like. Please note: All patrons must be wearing a wristband to enter the precinct.

IS THERE FOOD AVAILABLE AT THE FESTIVAL?

The Brighter Days Festival Food Court will be operating all weekend, from Friday 4.00pm with a variety of food and drink options for all the family.

WHERE CAN I PURCHASE MERCHANDISE AT THE EVENT?

The 2024 BDF Merchandise will be available from the Merchandise Shed, in the festival precinct from Friday night at 4.00pm, then Saturday and Sunday from 9.00am until sold out.

AM I ABLE TO BRING MY OWN CHAIR TO THE FESTIVAL?

Yes, feel free to bring your own chairs and picnic rugs. There is a 'chair-free' exclusion zone front of stage. You may leave your chairs at the precinct overnight at your own risk, and provided you leave the space around them rubbish free. You must take your chair home with you at the end of the event.

CAN I BRING ALCOHOL TO THE BRIGHTER DAYS FESTIVAL?

No, BYO is not permitted. Alcohol is available for purchasing from within the festival. The Brighter Days Festival is a no glass event. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol, after costs, go to support the Brighter Days Foundation.

WILL THERE BE SAFETY AND SECURITY?

Yes. The Brighter Days Festival has security patrols and local police presence. A manned First Aid tent will be in operation over the three days.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IN THE CASE OF WET WEATHER?

Our outdoor stage will go ahead rain, hail or shine unless the weather has been deemed dangerous or risking public safety. In the unlikely event that any/all parts of the Festival is to be cancelled an announcement will be made on site and through our social media channels.

ARE THERE PUBLIC TOILETS?

Yes, public toilets are located at various locations within the Festival precinct and will be well sign posted.

IS THERE ANY PUBLIC TRANSPORT?

Yes, buses Friday evening, all day Saturday and Sunday to and from Harrietville & Freeburgh, Porepunkah and Wandiligong. See our website or Facebook for details.

IS THERE A SHUTTLE BUS TO BRIGHT TOWNSHIP?

Yes there will be shuttle buses between the Festival Precinct and various designated bus stops around the Bright Township running at all times while the Festival is open. See our website or Facebook for details.

IS THERE PARKING AT THE FESTIVAL?

Yes, there is plenty of free parking at the Festival, and you are welcome to leave your car if you need to. (Please note there is no camping in cars or in the festival precinct allowed).

Cans FOR Cambodia








Entry to the public parking at Pioneer Park is from Coronation Avenue from the Churchill Avenue end.
