The Brighter Days Foundation was formed in 2012 to offer support to two charities; the DEBRA Foundation (Dystrophic Epidermolysis Bullosa Research Association) and SUDC (Sudden Unexplained Death In Childhood). Through a friend, whose child had been diagnosed with the debilitating EB disease, the band the Smokin' O'Briens played a backyard EB awareness gig where they met sufferers Eliza and Tilly.

So touched by the plight of these children, musicians Matt Powell, John Nixon and Steve Dundon decided to do something more to help. At the same time their bike-riding buddy Jim Henwood's close friends Rob and Kylie Trewin had lost their son Cooper to SUDC whilst another great mate and Bright local Jason Reid was experiencing first hand the trauma of a very sick child.

Collectively the guys wanted to do something that would make a real difference to those suffering.

They put their heads together and drew on the significant resources of their wider circle of friends who were also motorcycle and car enthusiasts and so the Brighter Days Foundation began.

With the festival now in its 8th year, we are proud to have donated over \$1.65 Million to our charities, a figure we could not have imagined when we started in 2013.

The anguish that parents and carers feel when they are inflicting excruciating pain on their child is something you never want to feel. The reality of Epidermolysis Bullosa is that sadly the care required is agonising bath and dressing changes for up to 3 hours every second day.

Through the generous support of Brighter Days DEBRA Australia can continue delivering their life changing programs which enables us to improve the quality of life for EB individuals and their families. It assists us to provide advocacy, aids and equipment, support services in the form of domestic, in home nursing, psychology, siblings, independent living, research and it gives families hope and makes their lives bearable in sometimes unbearable and hopeless situations.

DEBRA Australia is a not for profit volunteer based organisation that does not receive any





direct Government funding and works tirelessly to support those living with a rare skin blistering disease called Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB).

Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) is a rare disease whereby the skin blisters and peels at the slightest touch. Living with EB has been likened to living with third degree burns. It is very painful, and sufferers must be bandaged every day with dressings to protect and medicate their wounds.

It is estimated that there are around 1,000 people in Australia who have some form of EB and over 500,000 worldwide.

EB RESEARCH FOUNDATION

The EB Research Foundation is a registered not-forprofit charity established by family and friends of a beautiful little girl named Tilly Wilkes (pictured), born with Epidermolysis Bullosa 2011. The EB Research Foundation is dedicated to raising funds to invest in science & medical research that will lead to products and therapies for treating and ultimately curing Epidermolysis Bullosa as quickly and as efficiently as possible.

The EB Research Foundation has guickly become one of the world's largest investors into EB Research. Brighter Days has been a significant contributor and with your help, they have invested \$1.75M, driving progress in EB research through global collaboration, and continuing to make monumental strides in advancing research into life-changing therapies.

They've adopted a venture Philanthropy model meaning every dollar invested is multiplied potentially many times over and invested back into research.

Some of their achievements are

- Grown their global reach by partnering with leaders - EB Reserach Partnership - a non-profit, also established by families of children living with EB.
- Funding the best research They invest in projects



that could result in a meaningful therapy or a potential cure in three to five vears.

- Have provided funding towards 19 research projects in six different countries
- Collaborating with a leading universities and institutions around the world to advance clinical trials.
- There will be more clinical trials in EB in the next 3 years than there has been in the last 10 years combined.
- Within the next year, there will be several phase III clinical trials - the final stage before treatment approval then market.

These EB Research developments wouldn't be possible if it wasn't for people like you.

Cooper passed for no known reason and the foundation was established to support research into the cause of sudden and unexplained death in children.

As a parent who is told by a pathologist after an autopsy that we had a healthy little boy without sickness, injury or disease leaves a lot of unanswered guestions. We decided to establish research to try and help find a cause.

Cooper's connection to Brighter Days comes via committee members Jim & Lisa Henwood who heard Cooper's Dad talk at an event, deciding at that very moment to make a difference and help save other families from this same tragedy.



I first met Paul Hallam at a test ride for the new Harley Davidson Fat Bob at Geelong Harley. After hearing him speak, I was in awe of his knowledge and his guirky personality. We hit it off on our first ride, and very soon, he became my right hand man on H-DTV. In 6 seasons of H-DTV. we travelled thousands and thousands of km's, always talking via our helmet intercom systems, and very rarely were we not laughing. From Broome to Brisbane, Brisbane to Tasmania, across New Zealand, and to countless Hog rallies across Australia. He was a massive fan of our band Screamin' Eagles, and was a very proud supporter of our Brighter Days Festival. He loved judging the bike/car show'n'shine, and was always generous with his time as bike and car enthusiasts would always stop him for a chat. The son of Frank Hallam, who was Jack Brabham's engineer and the creator of the Repco engine, Paul inherited his dad's genius and was regarded as one of Australia's legendary engineering talents. He built the only ever Australian production motorcycle in just a few months, the X1R, and

no one to this day has ever come close to recreating what he achieved. We were proud to have him as part of the Brighter Days Festival, and I was proud to ride alongside him as we filmed HDTV. He was a beautiful soul, a little crazy and a lot of fun. He was a gun rider and my team at HDTV also loved the man.

We are honoured to have his wife Catherine and sons this year at BDF2020 to judge the new Paul Hallam Memorial Trophy for Best Bike in Show. The trophy will be a perpetual trophy, and each winner will receive a commemorative plaque.

BANDS

THIRSTY Merc

THIRSTY MERC are unquestionably one of Australia's finest live acts.

Having released 4 critically acclaimed albums, over 250,000 album sales under their belt, a finalist in the APRA Song of the Year for 20 Good Reasons (which also reached #1 on iTunes in Australia), 5 ARIA Award nominations, Thirsty Merc have found their way into the fabric of Australia's musical landscape.

Thirsty Merc formed in Sydney in 2002 releasing their debut EP, First Work, in September 2003, before being signed to Warner Music. The band's big break came in 2004 with the release of their debut, self titled, album which included the hits, Someday Someday and In The Summertime (the theme for Bondi Rescue since 2006).



Two more studio albums followed - Slideshows in 2007 (#4 ARIA Album) and Mousetrap Heart in 2010 (#14 on the ARIA Album chart) which included radio staples, 20 Good Reasons, Mousetrap Heart and Tommy and Krista.

In 2015, Thirsty Merc released Shifting Gears, their first wholly independent and first new material in five years, and spent the next 18 months crossing the country on 3 extensive tours, running up thousands of Frequent Flyer points and sold out shows. The first single The Good Life was nominated for Rock Work Of The Year at the 2017 APRA awards.

RUSSELL MORRIS

With a staggering 50 year career and counting, Russell Morris returns with his brand new album, Black And Blue Heart.

Produced by the very highly regarded Nick DiDia (Bruce Springsteen, Pearl Jam, Powderfinger) alongside co-producer Bernard Fanning, Russell continues to find unique ways to challenge himself creatively.

When Russell sent his Black And Blue Heart demos to Nick and Bernard, the producers were blown away immediately calling him to say they could not stop listening to the songs.



And through it all, Russell remains one of the hardest working musicians in the country. For some Artists a new album can almost write itself after almost six decades on the road but it takes a rare combination of talent and circumstances to realise that vision as vividly and succinctly as Russell Morris does on Black And Blue Heart.

BANDS

DARYL BRAITHWAITE

Right now Daryl Braithwaite is showing no signs of slowing down. Daft Punk recently sampled The Sherbs' 'We Ride Tonight'. In 2017 Daryl has entered the ARIA Hall of Fame as a solo artist

More than two decades on from the partnership that produced the multi-platinum albums 'Edge' (1988) and 'Rise' (1990), Sony Music Australia is ecstatic to announce the release of the legendary Daryl Braithwaite's album 'Days Go By!'

The album showcases Daryl's career highlights to date and features brand new music.

**In December 2017 Daryl's new Album enters the ARIA ALBUM CHARTS @ Number One..



Always a fine interpreter, here Daryl has recorded James Reyne's 'Motor's Too Fast', Peter Gabriel's 'In Your Eyes', Chicago's 'If You Leave Me Now', while reworking 'When We Were Kings' which featured in the 1996 documentary of the same name.

"I guess, overall, I'm happy I took up singing," says Daryl with his customary modesty. "I really am. And, without labouring the point, I think that I've been very fortunate to have had a lot of help from different people as well. It seems to have come together. Why it's lasted this long, I think it's because I love it. I love doing it, and I love audiences."

JON Stevens

Jon Stevens is recognised as one of the most talented rock musicians to emerge from Australia in recent memory. He has had phenomenal success as a solo artist, and as the lead singer of major rock acts Noiseworks, INXS and the Dead Daisies.

He's got the pedigree: a record- smashing debut at age 16 with two consecutive No. 1 singles in his New Zealand homeland, huge hits in Australia with Noiseworks and a 21st century lift off to worldwide acclaim at centre stage with INXS after the death of his friend Michael Hutchence.



In 2016 he joined forces with legendary musician, songwriter and Producer Dave Stewart (of Eurythmics) to record a new album, Starlight. Starlight bursts with a soulful artistry and honesty that's rare and borders on extinction today. All of the songs are co-written with Dave, who produced the album as well as played guitar. The first single 'HOLD ON' is classic powerhouse Jon Stevens. Different as they are, each track on Starlight overflows with feeling. Everything Stevens has survived, learned from, mastered and made leads to the album.

MOVING PICTURES

Moving Pictures began in 1979. Within a year, they had made their reputation as one of the best live acts in Sydney. They were all superb musicians, and in Alex Smith, they had an exceptional vocalist and world class front man. In 1981, they recorded their debut album, "Days Of Innocence", including the smash hit "What About Me", both of which went to the top on the charts. The band enjoyed several very successful years before the pressure of relentless touring took its toll, and, in 1987, they split. Alex went to London to with Harry Vanda and George Young, and spent many years working with some all-time rock legends. Garry formed the chart-topping band, "1927", while Ian, Mark and Charlie are the A-list of Australia's session musicians.

In 2011, Moving Pictures reformed for a 30th anniversary tour, which culminated in a sensational sold out show at Sydney's State Theatre, where the band's powerhouse set shook the



foundations. Every year since, they have toured Australia to rave reviews. The band are the best they have ever been.

Early in 2018, Moving Pictures were part of the sold out National Red Hot Summer Tour, where they played a killer set of all their hits, plus some awesome covers of rock classics.

DARLINGHURST

Darlinghurst is a band of individuals who bring their experience in music together to create a contemporary Country Music sound that has a unique finger print. Second single 'So Long So Long' is from the forthcoming debut album which will be released in 2020. Debut single 'Sorry Won't Get You Back' reached Number 1 on the Australian Country Music airplay chart (Sept/2019). Darlinghurst: JASON RESCH (guitar, vocals) is arguably the most successful Australian songwriter you've never heard of. With his mod-ish mop and immaculate vintage suits, Jason initially looks more suited to The Rolling Stones in 1965 than an alt-country-rock outfit in 2019, but Jase has dedicated a big chunk of his young life to his love of country, having lived and worked in Nashville for years before recently resettling back to his hometown of Melbourne. CASSIE LEOPOLD & PAGAN NEWMAN (vocals) were a duo long before their powerful harmonies helped forge the foundation of this new quartet. Wait until you hear these voices together!



Cass and Paigs: a force of nature, technically unrelated but inseparable sisters in life and song. MATT DARVIDIS (guitar, vocals) is both a prodigious guitarist and amazing vocalist who added the final piece to the Darlinghurst puzzle.

REECE MASTIN

Reece Mastin is loved all over the countryside and with a career kicking off in the 2000's after winning X Factor Australia in 2011 as a 16 year old and achieving so much at such a young age including 2x Platinum #1 albums, Three Consecutive chart topping Singles, Aria Chart #1,2 and #1 Singles respectively.
